

#### **Sunday Reflection**

In today's account the important point revolves around recognition of Jesus. Here we find this group of disciples at first failing to recognize Jesus and in the end, they recognize Him. What happened? Why did they at first think He was a stranger and later come to realize who He really was?

The Gospel account then takes us to the one thing that opened their eyes, the event that allowed them to make all of the connections, the central piece in the puzzle that opened their eyes. It was the breaking of the bread. The critical thing that occurred was when the "stranger" who was among them took bread, said the blessing, broke it and gave it to them to eat. Suddenly their eyes were opened and they recognized Him. They no longer saw Him with just their eyes, but they recognized Him with their hearts. They saw Him with their newly awakened faith. They recognized Him because they encountered Him in a totally different light. They saw Him now and in that event He promised to be with them always.

Knowledge isn't based simply on the acquisition of facts, information, and data. True knowledge is seeing things based on wisdom and understanding. Religious knowledge is seeing reality based on the gifts of the Holy Spirit, particularly His gifts of wisdom, understanding, and knowledge.

This is why we need times of reflection. This is why we need to get out of the busy-ness of our days. We need to turn off all of the noise that's hurled at us in this modern world of ours. For it is in moments of quiet reflection, when we're out for a stroll, or when we're in some quiet place where we're allowed to reflect, that we begin to "see" Jesus and come into a deeper awareness of His presence to us.

May you soon have some time to make your own reflections and come to recognize Him not only in the breaking of the bread but in all those other moments where God tries to break in on our time and walk with us as we face all of the stupendous events life hurls at us. For without His presence with us we certainly will feel depressed and defeated.
