Sunday Reflection

GOD is in control

The Gospel presents Jesus and His disciples embarking on the sea after a full day of teaching and preaching to the people. Jesus falls fast asleep aboard the ship. As a storm blows across the sea, the disciples become so frightened that they awake Jesus. After rebuking the storm, He turns to His disciples asking about their lack of faith.

Allowing GOD to be in control is a lesson all of us need to continually learn. It does not lessen the importance of our giving ourselves 100% to the tasks on hand. It, however, takes away the unhealthy anxiety and helps us to deal with the difficulties in life. Life is filled with challenges. The challenges can become so overwhelming that they de-energize us and paralyze us. It is only when we can surrender ourselves to GOD that GOD can demonstrate Who is in control.

For those who like order and structure in our lives, it can be particularly demoralizing when we realize we are not in charge and have no control of certain outside forces that affect our lives. What is important is that we can trust in the Lord Jesus and realize that GOD is in control. That means we must reach a point when we give up the selfish control that we desire to have, and hand things over to GOD. It demands trust in the our GOD, Who loves us more than we can ever know, and definitely more than we deserve. GOD truly wants the best for us and is working in our lives even while we face the most turbulent times. GOD is not inflicting us with problems, but GOD is with us through the problems.
